

# No cash for scrap



As of 1 September 2016,  
we are no longer allowed to  
pay cash for scrap metal.

## But we can still pay you!

Please discuss the range of  
alternative payment options  
with the weighbridge staff.

Under the Air Weapons and Licensing (Scotland)  
Act 2015, it is an offence for anyone to buy scrap  
metal for cash or by any other form of payment than  
a crossed cheque or electronic transfer of funds.

As well as banning cash payments, the  
Scottish Government has made it a  
requirement for us to verify the identity  
of those selling scrap metal.

### Acceptable forms of identification include:

- A valid photographic ID, which also sets out the seller's full name and residential address.
- A formal document, such as a utility bill, that bears the person's full name and residential address **and** a valid photographic ID that includes the seller's date of birth as well as their full name and residential address.

*All documentation must have been issued within three months of the date the metal is acquired by the dealer or no more than three months before the date the metal is disposed of by sale or exchange by the dealer.*
